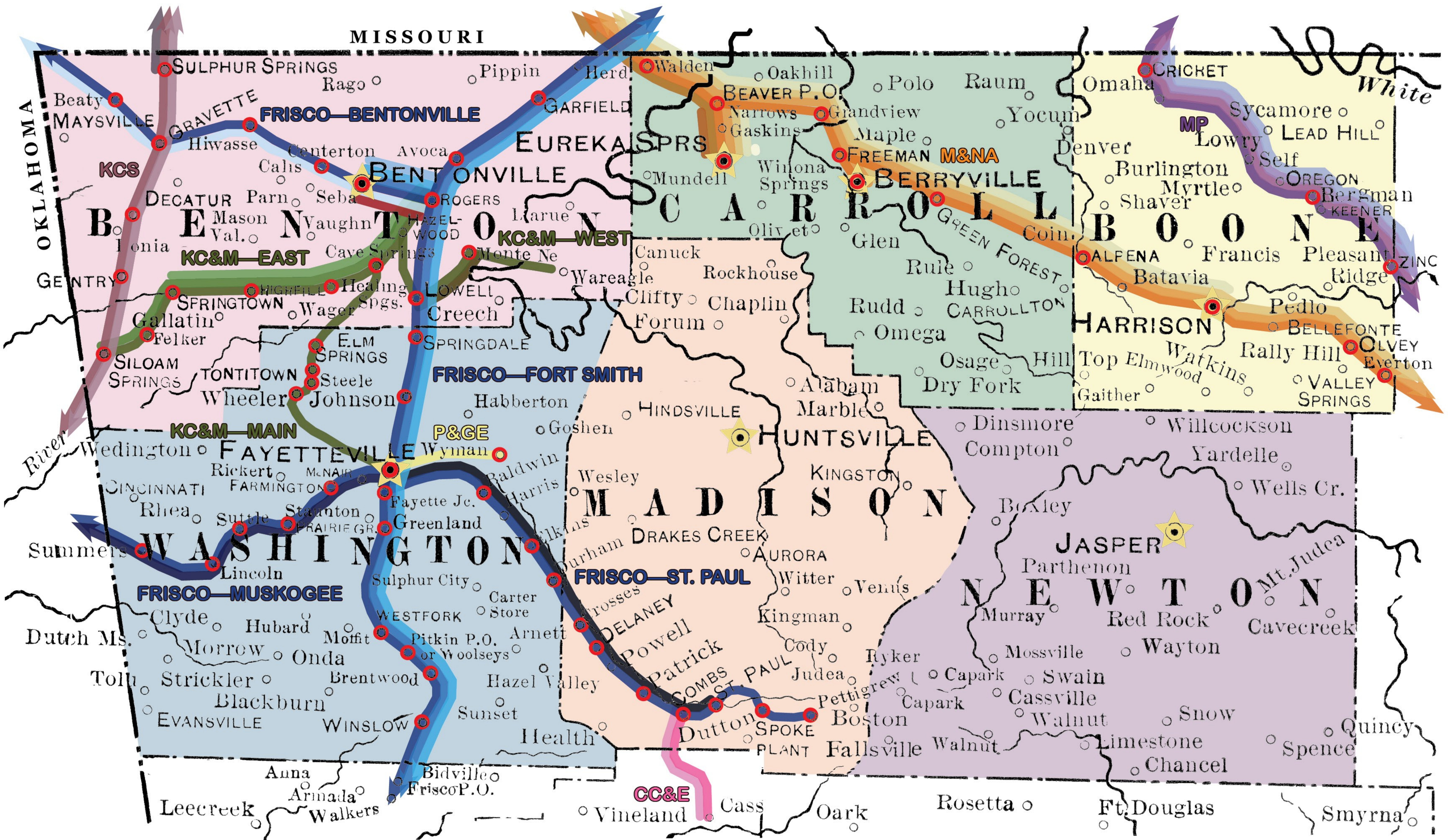


Railroads of Northwest Arkansas
