47th Annual Ozark Quilt Fair Shiloh Museum of Ozark History Saturday, September 13, 2025 10 am - 2 pm

Please read carefully as the rules and regulations for the Quilt Fair have changed.

When: Saturday, September 13, 2025, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. There is no rain date. If weather is questionable, call 479-750-8165 or watch our social media to find out about any event changes.

Cost: \$15 for exhibitors; free to the public. Registration fee includes one boxed lunch and drink.

Rules: All quilts must be 3 layers quilted by hand or by machine. Tops may be pieced, embroidered, or appliquéd (machine piecing is acceptable). No other forms of fiber crafts are allowed for exhibiting (e.g., cross-stitch, crochet, knitting, etc.)

Antique as well as new quilts are welcome. Antique quilts will be considered any quilt created before the year 2000, and new quilts will be considered any quilt created after the year 2000. All quilts should include a label indicating the history of the quilt (creator, history, date, and pattern). The museum will provide these labels for exhibitors prior to the event.

Registration deadline is Wednesday, September 10, 2025 by 5 p.m.

Exhibiting: Ropes will be stretched between trees or poles for hanging quilts. Each exhibitor may plan to use up to 15 feet of the ropes, unless space and number of quilters in attendance allow for more or less. Spaces are available on a first come, first served basis. Please bring chairs and tables if you want extra display space. Clothespins and cloth buffers are provided by the museum.

Security: Shiloh Museum staff and volunteers will be at the event all day, but YOU are the best security for your quilts. We encourage exhibitors to stay with their quilts to interact with the public. The public enjoys the opportunity to discuss the quilts with exhibitors.

Food: The registration fee of \$15 includes one boxed lunch for the exhibitor. Additional lunches may be purchased in advance for \$10 each.

Awards: Viewers Choice prizes will be awarded in both new and antique categories. First prize in each category is \$100; second prize is \$50; and third prize is \$25. Voting will end at 1:30 pm and awards will be presented at 2:00 p.m.

Quilt Sales: Sales of quilts will not be allowed on museum grounds. Attendees and quilters may make arrangements to buy or sell off museum property.
